Integrated Irrigation & Agricultural Livelihood Development in Killinochchi and Mullaitivu Districts

GCP/SRL/061/EC



The overall objective is to promote socio-economic development and economic integration of agricultural communities in the Northern Province in a participatory and sustainable manner.

Background:

The Project "Integrated Irrigation & Agricultural Livelihood Development in Killinochchi and Mullaitivu Districts" will focus on rehabilitating community irrigation infrastructure, improving water resource utilization, promoting crop diversification and developing agricultural-based livelihoods for vulnerable farming households in former conflict and flood- affected districts of Northern Sri Lanka.

Estimated results:

- Increased access to irrigation water and land availability for increased production of paddy, OFCs and homestead vegetables for community and household economic growth.
- 2. Model irrigation systems developed for sustainable resource utilization with strengthened and participatory community-based Farmers' Organizations.
- 3. Improved economic and household food security from increased crop production, resulting from improved access to water and new knowledge and practices in agriculture practices.
- 4. Strengthened agriculture extension capacity and outreach support of District level Department of Agriculture (DoA) and Department of Agrarian Development (DoAD) outreach staff.

Main activities:

Rehabilitation of minor tanks covering up to 4,165 ha area and rehabilitation of up to 1,200 ha abandoned land; revitalized community-based Farmers' Organizations (FO's); increased agricultural production for 17,200 vulnerable farming families through improved variety of seeds and technical training; and training of agricultural extension staff in agriculture and water management.
